WIZARD OF OZ

The Wizard of Oz performance is fast approaching and excitement is building. There will be three performances – Wednesday 15^{th} May and Thursday 16^{th} May, both starting at 7.30pm and a matinee performance on Thursday 16^{th} May which will start at 10am. Tickets will be on sale from Tuesday 23^{rd} April at the school office between 8.40-9.00am, 1.50-2.10pm and 2.50-3.10pm. Tickets will cost 6.00 for each.





We would ask that individuals buy tickets for one performance only to allow all families to see their children sing and perform. Tickets are numbered to indicate a specific row and seat. Seats are for any person of school age and above (please no pre-school children or buggies/ prams) and all persons attending must have a ticket.

Our pupils will enjoy a performance of the show on Tuesday 14th May.

Information about additional rehearsals for Wizard of Oz was shared on the School Story on Class Dojo yesterday afternoon. Please keep a note of these rehearsals. It is important that we have a full turn out. Thank you for your understanding and support with this.

As a thank you to the children involved in the show- all cast can have Friday 17th May as a day off (if they wish). This will not affect your child's overall attendance. Each year we enter a team of swimmers from the school, to take part in relays and individual races (one length). It is only for P6 & P7 (though P5's can swim in the P6 races if there are not enough P6 children to fill the quota and if they're a member of a swimming club) children and they can enter only one individual race. There will also be two relays - freestyle & the Apple Blossom Shield - which children will be selected to swim in. The event is due to start at 9:45am sharp. It usually lasts until around 3pm but may finish earlier. Although the gala is competitive, it is always a fun and rewarding day for all those who take part.
