## Literacy

### We are learning about:

- Traditional stories and stories from other cultures.
- Predict story endings.
- Re-tell stories and poems with a sense of audience and intonation.
- Use setting and re-describe in own writing.
- Use adjectives to create a character profile.
- Know features of poetry and write own lines based on poems.
- Order alphabetically.
- Use dictionaries/glossaries appropriately and make a glossary.
- Locate words.
- Create a flowchart to explain a process.
- Past tense verbs and speech marks.
- Text can be presented in different ways.
- Syllables.

## Our Topic: Hot and Cold Countries

### Ask me what I am learning about in class:

- The Arctic and Antarctica – weather, landscape, Inuit people and animals.
- Seasonal changes.
- Global warming and looking after our world.

## Numeracy

### We are learning about:

- Count in 2s, 5s and 10s.
- Compare and order numbers to 100.
- Number bonds to 10 and 100.
- Add 9 or 11.
- Odd and even numbers.
- Adding a single digit, 10 and teen to a two-digit number.
- Add a single digit and a 2-digit number with bridging.
- Add three numbers.
- Add amounts to 99p including 50p coin.
- 2D shape.
- O'clock and half past times.
- Estimate, measure and compare masses.
- Recognise the kilogram and half kilogram and use scales.

## Topic Vocabulary

### These are words I am learning about in our topic work:

- Arctic and Antarctica – globe, seasons, weather, landscape, polar bear, penguin, environment, seasonal changes, Inuit, camouflage, predator, prey.
- Global warming – reduce, reuse, recycle.
