Literacy

We are learning about:

- Write sustained stories
- Understand how humour is created
- Write own riddles, tongue-twisters, jokes, puzzles, nonsense sentences or alliterative sentences
- Investigate a range of different texts
- Speech Bubbles
- Captions and Sub-Headings
- Listen to different texts and comprehend in written form and verbally
- Understand nouns, verbs, adjectives and synonyms
- Use commas in lists
- Features of non-chronological reports
- Texts presented in different ways
- Revisiting vowels and consonants

Our Topic: The Farm

Ask me what I am learning about in class:

- The Farm – past/present farms, ‘The Grain Chain’, animals – how they grow and use their senses, seasonal changes in the landscape, farm safety

We are learning about:

- Describe and extend simple number sequences to 100
- Count in 2s, 5s and 10s
- Revisit Subtracting multiples of 10s from a 2 digit number
- Tell the time using digital and analogue clocks
- Use quarter past, half past and o'clock on digital and analogue clocks
- Revisit properties of 3D shapes
- Revisit Subtract 9/19 from 2 digit numbers
- Revisit Subtract 11/21 from 2 digit numbers
- Fractions – Halves and Quarters
- Subtracting across 20 using bridging
- Capacity
- Area of shapes
